The models...

- Each portion has a stitch count of 88 x 55 – and fits nicely into the “Petite” size frames from Olde Colonial Designs when stitched on 40 count silk gauze; the one shown here is #2314-01.
- When stitched over one, you have the perfect size to embellish an ornament or special gift tag.
- The model shown here on 28ct linen makes a very cheerful pillow for your holiday décor
- My personal favorite is the memory tray (Hobby Lobby #172577). I had some great cotton fabrics that complimented the colors nicely, then added some old black buttons, a 1930's Christmas greeting card, plus a teeny little pendant with its own little stitched heart (on 30ct gauze). I found the “believe” embellishment at the craft store and finished it all off with a festive bow. So many possibilities here...
